Antique American Indian, pre-Columbian, Spanish Colonial, and contemporary American Indian art star this weekend at the Marin Civic Center in [San Rafael, Calif.](#)

The Marin Show, now in its 28th year, attracts top dealers, passionate collectors, artists, and the culture-curious from around the world. The event is set for Saturday and Sunday, with a Friday-night preview gala to benefit [local residential-assistance/homeless shelter services.](#)

In addition to Native American-created jewelry, textiles, baskets, pottery, sculpture, beadwork, and paintings, the show will also feature lectures by esteemed experts on the American Indian experience including discussions on when, how and from where the first humans entered North America and the unique ceremonial regalia of those in the San Francisco Bay area, and the authors of a new book about equine bridles through the years will sign copies. An appraisal clinic will also be held for collectors.
